

# THANKS!!

The 29th Annual Rabun Rendezvous- postponed by Winter Storm Jonas- is now behind us! And a huge "THANK YOU" to Chairman Ray King and his crew for a successful event. Preliminary figures seem to indicate we successfully exceeded last year's net revenue, in spite of a lower than expected attendance. Now, it's onward to the budget planning.

In addition, Kent Wilson and I are heading up the new draft of our Chapter's Strategic Plan. And, after a number of suggestions about changing the time of year to host Rendezvous, I will open that up for discussion at this month's Chapter meeting, and prior to our February Board meeting.

A couple things that need our immediate attention: 1. We have to turn in our Dream Trip ticket money at the FEBRUARY MEETING, so Kathy can turn in one check and all stubs at the March 5th Georgia Council meeting. Bring your money- checks made out to Rabun TU- and your ticket stubs to the meeting on February 16th. 2. For the Alaska trip in June or September this year, I will need your chosen week and deposit by no later than the March 22nd Chapter meeting. The deposit check should be made out to Rabun TU, with Alaska in the memo section, and will be one-half the total. 3. March 19th is Rabunite 101- so see Charlie Breithaupt for applications for those wanting to attend. Hoot-on-the-Hootch is also that day, when Dream Trip winners are announced. We need a LARGE contingent from the Chapter to go, as they strongly supported us at Rendezvous. 4. Finally, we need one or two people to volunteer to coordinate our Spring Campout scheduled for April 6th- 10th. Main thing is to coordinate who is cooking.


