SOME NOTEWORTHY NEWS:

THE U.S.F.S. AND S.C. GAME AND FISH STOCKED THE CHATTOOGA BETWEEN HIGHWAY 28 AND BURRELLS FORD WITH FIVE INCH RAINBOWS. ABOUT 1000 FISH WERE PLACED BY HELICOPTER AT 11 LOCATIONS. LETS WATCH FOR THESE LITTLE FELLOWS THIS WINTER AND HOPE A BUNCH MAKE IT TO SPRING.

YOU MAY HAVE NOTICED GEORGIA FISH AND GAME WILL ASK FOR INCREASES IN LICENSE FEES FOR NEXT YEAR. IF GRANTED THESE MONIES WOULD EXPAND WMA HOLDINGS AND ALSO BRING FEES MORE IN LINE WITH OTHER SOUTHEASTERN STATES.

OUR WILDERNESS AREAS HAVE EXPANDED. IN LINE WITH THE LAND & RESOURCE MANAGEMENT PLANS, SEVERAL AREAS HAVE BEEN DESIGNATED AS WILDERNESS AREAS.
