





IT SEEMS THAT EVERY TIME YOU TURN AROUND THE DAM BUILDERS ARE WAITING. NOW IT STHE PROPOSED TWO FORKS DAM ON THE SOUTH PLATTE RIVER NEAR DENVER. THE 555 FOOT DAM WOULD INUNDATE 20 MILES OF TROUT RIVER THAT CONTAINS ONE OF THE HIGHEST WILD TROUT POPULATIONS IN NORTH AMERICA, OVER 700 LBS. PER SURFACE ACRE.
