- 2. CAMPGROUND AT RIDLEY: Needs a lot of work!
- 3. DARNELL CREEK: Committee appointed to survey and see if timber cutting activity is creating the silt problems or if it comes from another source.
- 4. CHARLIE'S CREEK: No immediate work needs to be done by T U.
