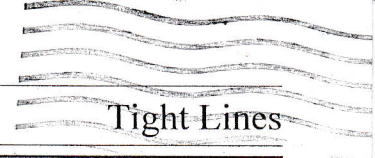
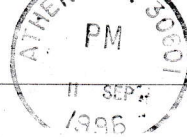
## September's Work Project and Campout

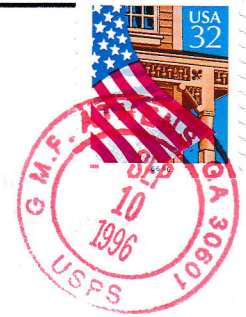
