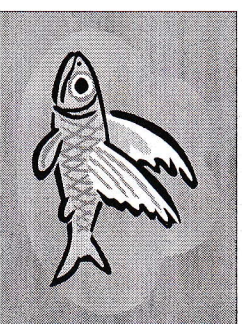
Planning for 2002
