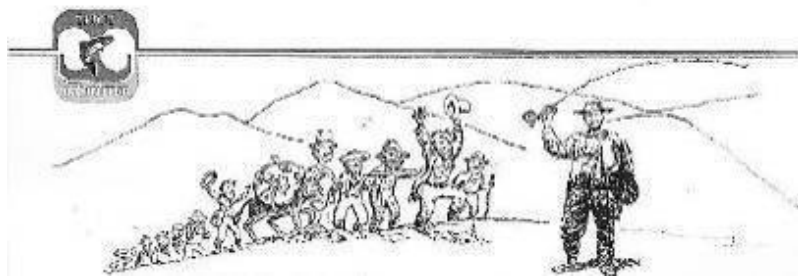
Call for A Volunteer

Way to Go Laurel!

Laurel Smith (TFS Class of '20) of Clayton, Georgia, is making a meaningful impact in fisheries conservation. After earning her B.S. in Forestry Resources from the University of Georgia in 2025, Laurel spent recent months working with the National Park Service's Native Fisheries Conservation Crew at Yellowstone National Park. Alongside fisheries biologists, she helped collect critical population estimates, biological samples, and environmental data to support conservation plans for Westslope Cutthroat Trout and Arctic Grayling.

In addition to working with native trout species, she also worked with invasive species through the lake trout suppression program at Yellowstone Lake. This suppression program is essential for restoring the Yellowstone Cutthroat, a keystone species, which has had a cascading positive effect on the overall ecosystem. She intends to return next season to continue this research and hopes to work towards a Master of Fisheries Biology degree.

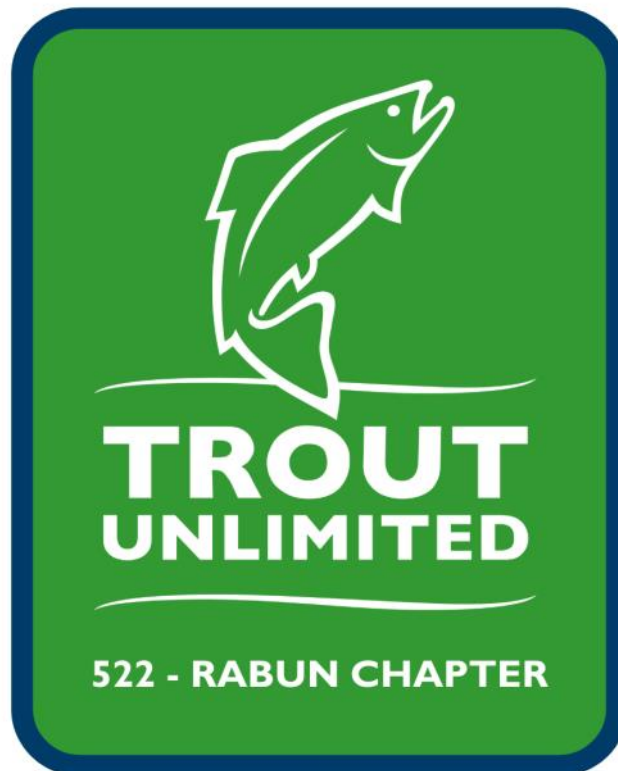

HEAD: BRASS BEAD.



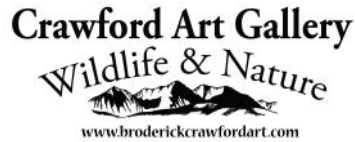
